Connection cables will also be prepared on site. The default resolution is 1024 X 768. Please consider those conditions if you use other OS. It is possible to use your own laptop. If you want to use other types of computers such as Macintosh, please bring a suitable adapter by yourself. It is still recommendable not to use your laptop for saving the time for connection.

In case you use your computer, please check the connection status between your computer and the projector.

INSTRUCTION FOR USING YOUR OWN COMPUTER

Voltage & Frequency

Electricity in Republic of Korea is 220 Volts, alternating at 60cycles per second. If you plan to bring a device that does not accept 220 Volts at 60 Hertz to Jeju, you will need a voltage converter.

Plug Adapters & Connector

Outlets in Republic of Korea generally accept 1 type of plug: Two Round Pins



If your appliances plug has a difference shape, you need a plug adapter.

The connector to the projector is a VGA cable shown below.




If you bring other types of computer such as Macintosh, please bring as suitable adapter by yourself.
